



## Lillian Faye Townsend-Sandle

June 27, 1936 - November 12, 2018

Lillian Faye Townsend-Sandle, fondly known as “Ain'ta Faye”, by family members and close friends, because of her determination and strong will to fight against the odds, signifying there is nobody like her. She entered into the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ on November 12, 2018, at her home with family with her. She was born on June 27, 1936, to the late Rev. E.D. and Caroline Townsend, in Granger TX, and attended Christopher Attic High School, before the family moved to Temple, TX., in 1950, where she attended and graduated from Dunbar Junior-Senior High School in 1955.

Mrs.Sandle was an advocate of higher education and her educational journey began upon graduating from a CNA Program working toward her Masters in Nursing and Legal Nursing Associate degree. She was a certified nuclear medication technician, a certified notary, and a certified paralegal. She was employed as a nurse for over 25 years at the VA Hospital in Marlin TX., and in Denver. She worked at Scott & White Hospital in Temple, TX, Denver General Hospital, and several nursing homes in the Denver, CO. and Temple. TX. for many years before retiring.

Her journey didn't stop with equipping only herself in education, she was known for helping and encouraging others to get their education, by giving and doing all she could do to see to it that each person who desired to attain educationally was granted the opportunity. She was very much involved in the civil right movement in the 1960's, and was a life time member of the NAACP. Out of all of her accomplishments, she would proudly tell you that her greatest

accomplishment in life was receiving the Lord Jesus Christ at an early age at St. Love All Baptist Church in Granger, TX., where she was baptized under the pastoral leadership of the late Rev. O. S. Davis. She found joy serving the Lord, helping the poor and needy, the elderly, and those whom she felt were disenfranchised. She was dedicated to her mission call and her reasonable Christian duty of reaching out to others who called upon her, even during her own times of sickness she was known to get out of her sick bed to go to another who was in need. Her daily testimony was one of her favorite gospel hymns:

“If I can If I can help somebody, as I travel along  
If I can help somebody, with a word or song  
If I can help somebody, from doing wrong  
No, my living shall not be in vain.”

She was ordained and licensed as an Evangelist by the late Rev. C.L. Scott through By Faith Baptist Church in Denver, Colorado, and was founder and President of Missions Outreach Ministry for over 50 years. She was preceded in death by her son Leo Darrel Sandle, her parents Rev E.D. and Caroline Townsend, a sister Gladys Townsend, and two brothers Jerry and E.D. Townsend, Jr. She is survived by her daughter Sharron (George) Williams, three grandsons Cory and Jason Sandle, and Nathan Williams; two granddaughters Latasha and Stacy Sandle; three sisters, Doris Lee, Nancy and Ella Townsend; nieces Carolynne Moody, Phyllis Henderson, Patricia Morris, Natalie Cross, Stephanie Puryear, Andrea Moody, Gladys Rowser, Valerie Townsend; eight nephews Edward E. Townsend, Gerome Townsend, Vance Townsend, Louis and Eric Ferenchak, Jerry, Jr., Jerry III, and Dr. Kevin Townsend-Wilson, and her very special favorite cousin-sister Doris Hodge, and a host of cousins and friends.
